Areca Palm

The areca palm, often called the bamboo palm, is a popular houseplant because of its low-light tolerance. It has enormous fronds that are green and fluffy and have a little sway.



Chinese Fan Palm

They stand apart from other palms by its unusual star-shaped leaves rather than its more common feathery fronds. Although this palm species grow slowly, in maturity, it may reach a height of 15 feet or more.
