I am excited as I write this letter of introduction to you. I am Linda Morris, your new pastor. My husband David and I are both pastors. David will be serving at Guthrie Center and Bowman Chapel.

I am honored to be called to serve here at Adel and Dallas Center and eager to begin working alongside you in ministry to these communities and beyond. I am a licensed local pastor and have been serving in this capacity for 13 years with 2 years prior to that as a supervised certified lay speaker.

I grew up in Akron which is about 30 miles north of Sioux City along the Sioux River. I am a retired registered nurse. In my nursing career I worked intensive care, post intensive care, case management and for a cardiology group as their hospital based nurse. My last job in nursing was as a home hospice nurse.

One of my passions in ministry is mission. I believe we are all called to share the love of God with others in tangible ways. The churches I served in Davenport had a growing ministry to the homeless which opened my eyes to the needs of the homeless and those who struggle each day to barely make ends meet. I look forward to hearing about your missional work as a congregation.

Another love is facilitating Bible studies. In one of the churches I served, we worked our way through the Disciple Bible Study Fast Track of both the Old and New Testaments. This is a commitment, but I feel without a commitment to study God's word I would not be the person I am today.

I felt called to begin the process of becoming a licensed local pastor when we lived in Emmetsburg. I had known for some time that nursing was no longer for me and that God was calling me to work in ministry of some kind. I was asked to serve at Dolliver UMC as a certified lay speaker and I was instantly drawn to preaching and nurturing a congregation.

I feel my years as a nurse serve as a good background for my ministry of caring for people, visitation, and counseling those who grieve as well as being a non-judgmental listening ear. To help foster this, I have taken the Stephen Ministry Leadership training and Grief Share leadership training.


